## **SCCA Sends Aid to Florida**

The South Carolina Cattlemen's Association (SCCA), along with the South Carolina Farm Bureau (SCFB), joined forces with the National Cattlemen's Beef Association's Region II to send a truck and trailer load of fencing materials to the areas of Florida hardest hit by Hurricane Charley. John Queen, farmer from North Carolina, coordinated the effort in which all of the states in the Region II area contributed to the effort. Here in South Carolina, leaders of SCCA and SCFB recognized the importance of helping out our neighbors in times of need.

"You never know when South Carolinians may need the same type of help following a storm that hits us," commented Louis Tisdale, president of SCCA.

Fencing wire and T posts were included in the load that was due to arrive in Florida on August 31.

**December 1**—Members who did not renew in November would receive a second invoice. As the membership is received, the local association would receive their portion of the dues from SCCA.

**January 1**—Local association would receive a list of all renewing members and non-renewing members. At this point, the local association would have the opportunity to recruit renewals and new members and send the state dues to SCCA as we have done in the past.

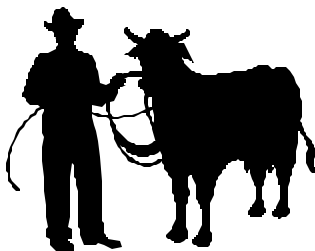
# Owens Requests Meeting Schedules
